“HOW TO QUILT” SPIRAL SUNS #2299-11

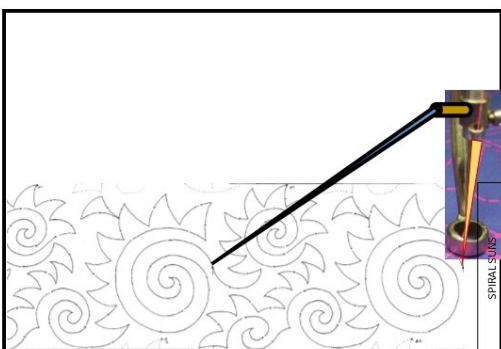
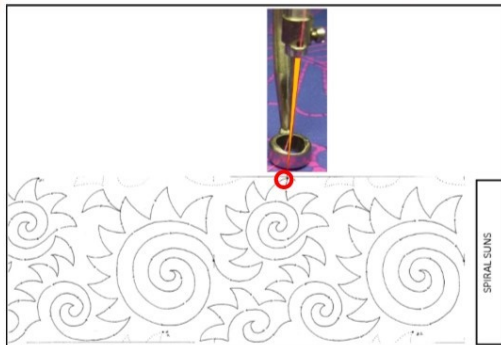
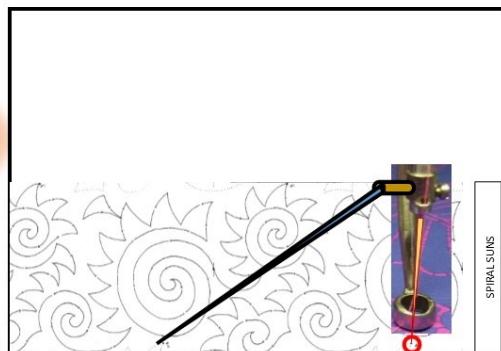
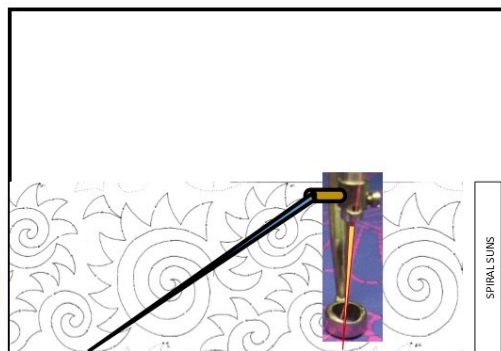

With the “1,2,3” plan - From the bottom right corner.

The arrows on MeadowLyon patterns are drawn pointing left in the expectation the quilter will start stitching at the bottom right corner of the quilt.

If you desire to start quilting at the top right corner of the quilt, you should **SWITCH** the numbers. Replace the #1 with a “2.” and the #2 with a “1.”

(You may also reverse the pattern on your table and begin at the repeat dot if desired. You’ll have to go against the arrows In that case.)



4. After rolling the quilt again, start at the original place used for the first row. Repeat for additional rows.

3. Lift needle and move it to the edge of the quilt choosing a place on the pattern to begin stitching. (See 2nd sheet.)

2. After rolling, place the needle, once again, into the spot that you have marked. (Don’t be surprised, it should line up with the #2 below the large spiral.) Adjust the laser light to the closest #2 spot to the left, on the pattern.

1. After completing the first row across, put needle down into #1. Either mark that spot, or roll the quilt with the needle down.

To start: Place the needle at the beginning of the design. Adjust laser to the beginning of the repeat and stitch across the quilt.
